



Suncoast Music Scholarships will award up to \$20,000 in music education scholarships to 10th through 12th grade music students who reside in Sarasota or Manatee County and qualify through a competition.

This program is offered through a Sarasota Music Club and Artist Series Concerts of Sarasota partnership.

AWARDS

Awards for 10th and 11th grade students are to be used for expenses related to the study of music, such as paying for private lessons, instrument purchase or repairs, music camps, etc.

10th grade students – two \$1,000 scholarships

11th grade students – two \$2,000 scholarships

Awards for 12th grade students are to be used for music education purposes, ideally for a music program at a college or university.

1st Place - \$5,000

2nd Place - \$4,000

3rd Place - \$3,000

4th Place - \$2,000

Completed applications are due by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, February 28, 2017.

AUDITIONS

Auditions will be held on Saturday, April 22, 2017, at the Symphony Center, 709 N. Tamiami Trail, Sarasota. You will be notified by April 1, 2017, of the time to appear for your audition.

The applicant is required to perform a minimum of two pieces of music which must be of contrasting styles and from different periods. Performance time must total no less than 4 minutes and no longer than 10 minutes.

Applicants must bring an original copy and two photocopies of the music to be performed to the audition for the judges, if applicable.

Judging will be based on Technique, Memorization, Musicality and Presentation.

ACCOMPANIST

Any accompanist should be experienced in playing the audition pieces with the applicant.

If pre-recorded music is needed to accompany the audition performance, a CD copy of the music must be included with the application form.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

The 12th grade winners will perform at the awards luncheon, which will be held on May 6, 2017, at Michael's On East in Sarasota.
